One weekend, little Reese started throwing up a lot, so her mother took her to their local pediatrician that following Monday. She continued to get sick and was rushed to the local hospital where she was admitted.

On her fourth day at the hospital, Reese had a seizure. Almost immediately, she was taken to have a CT scan and an MRI that revealed a brain tumor.

Reese's mom said, "I was determined to find the best place for her to go and get treatment. I didn't want to lose my child." So she did some research and discovered that there was a place that could help Reese. And then she obtained a referral from her doctor to go to St. Jude. "Once we were here, I definitely knew we were in the right place," said Reese's mom.

St. Jude doctors placed the little girl on a treatment plan that includes four months of chemotherapy and 30 rounds of proton radiation, followed by six more months of oral chemotherapy.
